Registrations and Player Movement:

Division 1 Women Cassie Seeley, Maroochydore Pursuant to the discussion at the last General Meeting in regards to Cassie Steeley (Caboolture Div 2W) being eligible to play across Clubs (into Div 1W - Maroochydore) and the consensus from that meeting for a ruling by Greg Richards, it has been confirmed by Greg that such a move would be in the best interests of Cassie's hockey development and thus has his full approval for such an arrangement to take place.

Records Amendment:

Division 2 Women Caloundra v Flinders Played 15 May – game recorded as draw as per card. However, game did start 15 minutes late – therefore – Un-notified forfeit recorded against Flinders ROP 6.2 and 8.5. Score now recorded 5-0 to Caloundra. Three premiership points to be deducted from Flinders as per ROP 7.4

DUAL Registrations:

According to Rules of Play 5.15 – penalties apply for not submitting Dual Registration Forms by the due date.

5.15 Dual Registration

- (a) Players who are registered with more than one Association are only eligible to participate in SCHA fixtures after they have complied with Clause 5.15 (b) and (c).
- (b) Players seeking primary dual registration shall apply to the Association Secretary on the Hockey Queensland dual registration form after endorsement by the Primary Club. Primary dual registered players may participate in fixtures once registered by their Primary Club.
- (c) Players seeking primary dual registration must submit a dual registration form after endorsement by the Primary Club by 12noon on the Monday following the second fixture played by the player in the player's registered team.
- (d) Players seeking secondary dual registration shall apply to the Association Secretary on the relevant Hockey Queensland dual registration form after endorsement by the Primary Club, Primary Association and Secondary Club and receive written approval prior to participating in any fixture, once registered by their Secondary Club.
